FEATURES AND BENEFITS

- Made In The USA
- Mortise & Tenon Joint This joint is used on all 90° angles (whenever a vertical piece is connected to a horizontal piece).
 When constructed properly, the joint is stronger than the wood itself.
- <u>Hand-Rubbed Stains</u> Penetrate deep into the wood, bringing out the natural characteristics of each piece.
- <u>Solid Wood Construction</u> Hand selected solid oak, and maple are strong and durable and domestically sourced from sustainable resources.
- <u>Steam Bending</u>– An old world craftsmanship technique that bends solid wood preventing seams and weak points.
- <u>Dado Joint</u> Groove created in drawer box into which the drawer bottom is slid into securely. The joint ensures the drawer bottoms won't fall out of place. Adds strength and stability to the drawer.
- <u>Catalyzed Varnish</u> Resistant to heat and moisture Also resistant to marring and scratching.
- <u>English Dovetail Drawer Boxes</u> Adds durability, strength, and stability.
- <u>Drawer Slides</u> High quality, full extension, ball bearing slides.
